Who puts on Warrenville Summer Daze?

Warrenville Summer Daze is an event put on by the Warrenville Park District, City of Warrenville and the Western DuPage Chamber of Commerce.

Do you have an event website?

Will seating be available?

On-site seating will be limited. We recommend bringing your own lawn chairs, etc.

What types of payment are accepted?

As always, cash is accepted. We will also have card payment processing via Square App at the info and beer token tents.

Are there any free kid's activities?

Yes! Friday, August 5 - Face Painting (5-7P), Warrenville Park District Inflatables (5-8P), and Friendly Farms Petting Zoo & Pony Rides (6-8P); Saturday, August 6 - Miss Liz Children's Musician(2-3P), Face Painting (2-4P), Painting with Pinot's Palette of St. Charles (4-6P), Crosstown Exotic Animals Show (5-6P or 6:30-7:30P), Warrenville Park District Inflatables (5-8P)

Can I register for the Car Show on Saturday?

Yes, day of registration begins at 8A.

What time is the Car Show?

Saturday from 10A-3:30P, or when judging is complete. Awards will be announced at approximately 3:30P. We ask that all participants wait until all awards have been announced to leave their parking spot for the safety of spectators and other participants.

Can I bring my own beverages?

We do not allow any outside food or beverages. We will have food, water, soda, beer and wine for sale.

What types of beer and wine will be available?

Miller Lite, MGD, Leinenkugel's Summer Shandy, Modelo, Two Brothers Wobble and Domaine DuPage; Mike's Hard Lemonade; White Claw Black Cherry and Mango; Black Oak Cabernet Sauvignon and Chardonnay Wine

What are the beer and wine token prices?

Beer and wine tokens are \$5 each.

What food vendors will be there?

Marino's Kitchen, Doggie Diner, Churro Babes, and Kool Kat Ice Cream. All food vendors accept cash and credit cards.

Can I bring my dog?

No dogs are allowed.

Where can I park?

Off-street parking is available near the City Hall complex, the Warrenville Park District and surrounding areas.

Is there handicapped parking available?

Handicapped parking is available on Rockwell near the library. During the car show, handicapped parking is available on Tracy Place next to the Police Station. After the Car Show on Saturday, handicapped parking will be available along Warren Avenue across from the Community Building.
